

**ABORIGINAL HERITAGE ACT 2006**

**AREA BOUNDARIES IN RELATION TO REGISTERED ABORIGINAL PARTIES**

**GUNAIKURNAI LAND AND WATERS ABORIGINAL  
CORPORATION**

**(Registered 23/05/2008. Modified 18/09/2008. Modified 03/12/2010)**

The boundary begins in Warragul township at the junction of Brandy Creek Road (as Victoria Street), the Korumburra-Warragul Road (as Alfred Street) and the Drouin-Warragul Road (as Queen Street) and continues progressively clockwise:

- north-westerly along the Drouin-Warragul Road (as Queen Street and Princes Way) to where the eastern off-ramp of the Princes Freeway enters that road
- continuing north-westerly along that off-ramp and along the northern carriageway of that freeway to the point where it crosses Buln Buln Road
- easterly and then northerly along that road for about 4.1 kilometres to its intersection with Lockwood Road (not in the VicRoads Country Street Directory of Victoria, Edition 7) and an unnamed track at longitude 145.894251 latitude -38.107878
- east south easterly in a straight line from that intersection for about 1300 metres to the end of Cazalys Road at longitude 145.909387 latitude - 38.109774
- continuing easterly along that road to its junction with Brandy Creek Road
- north-westerly along that road to its junction with Old Sale Road
- easterly along that road to its junction with the Mizpah Settlement Road
- generally north-easterly along that road to its junction with McDougals Road
- generally north-westerly and then northerly along that road to its junction with Inglemans Road
- northerly and then generally easterly along that road to its junction with Brigg Track
- generally easterly along that track to its junction with Vespar Track (not named in the VicRoads Directory)
- northerly along that track for about 200 metres to its junction with Mill Track (not named in the VicRoads Directory)
- easterly along that track to its junction with Beards Track (not named in the VicRoads Directory)
- northerly along that track to its junction with Stoll Road

- north-easterly along that road to its end at longitude 146.097243 latitude -38.024913
- easterly in a straight line from that point for about 400 metres to a point on an unnamed stream (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 146.101645 latitude -38.025089
- easterly downstream along that stream to where it enters the La Trobe River
- generally south-easterly downstream along that river for about 1500 metres to where it is entered by Stony Creek (not named in the VicRoads Directory)
- generally north-easterly upstream along that creek to where it is entered by an unnamed stream (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 146.130345 latitude -38.021567
- continuing north-easterly upstream along that creek to its source at longitude 146.144255 latitude -38.008449
- easterly in a straight line from that point for about 320 metres to a point on Willow Grove Road at longitude 146.147865 latitude -38.008449
- south-easterly along that road to its junction with Russell Creek Track
- generally north-easterly along that road to its junction with Rowleys Ridge Road (not named in the VicRoads Directory)
- continuing north-easterly along that road to its junction with Tanjil Junction Road
- easterly for about 150 metres along that road to where it crosses the Tanjil River East Branch
- northerly upstream along that river to where it is entered by Long Creek
- north-easterly upstream along that creek to its source at longitude 146.280627 latitude -37.863362
- northerly from that point along the ridge line for about 2.5 kilometres to the junction of three unnamed tracks (not in the VicRoads Directory) at Baw Baw Alpine Village at longitude 146.277898 latitude -37.843553
- northerly along one of those tracks for about 1.5 kilometres to its junction with another unnamed track (not in the VicRoads Directory) on the western edge of Baw Baw National Park
- north-easterly along that track, through that park, to its end at the Australian Alps Walking Track
- north-westerly along that walking track for about 3 kilometres to longitude 146.273937 latitude -37.809658
- north in a straight line from that point for about 350 metres to a point on Whitelaw Creek at longitude 146.273848 latitude -37.806841

- northerly downstream along that creek to where it enters the Thomson River
- northerly downstream along that river to longitude 146.298940 latitude -37.701810
- north north-easterly in a straight line from that point for about 3.1 kilometres to longitude 146.305631 latitude -37.673550
- west north-westerly in a straight line from that point for about 15.7 kilometres to the edge of the Yarra Ranges National Park at the junction of Nine Mile Road and the Warburton – Woods Point Road
- north-easterly and then south-easterly along that road to its junction with Walhalla Road
- easterly along that road for about 14 kilometres to longitude 146.338029 latitude -37.615444
- northerly in a straight line from that point for about 1500 metres to longitude 146.337765 latitude -37.601710
- easterly in a straight line from that point for about 1500 metres to longitude 146.355108 latitude -37.601446
- southerly in a straight line from that point for about 1 kilometre to longitude 146.355460 latitude -37.610602
- easterly in a straight line from that point for about 2.5 kilometres to Mt Selma Road at longitude 146.383369 latitude -37.610338
- easterly along that road for about 3.6 kilometres to a point at longitude 146.412028 latitude -37.609443
- north in a straight line from that point for approximately 1.8 kilometres to a point at longitude 146.412252 latitude -37.592933
- west in a straight line from that point for approximately 1.5 kilometres to a point at longitude 146.394876 latitude -37.592926
- generally north-easterly in a straight line from that point for approximately 4 kilometres to a point at longitude 146.404227 latitude -37.556979
- east in a straight line from that point for approximately 5 kilometres to a point at longitude 146.461029 latitude -37.557004
- south in a straight line from that point for approximately 1 kilometre to a point at longitude 146.461117 latitude -37.566174
- east in a straight line from that point for approximately 2.7 kilometres to a point at longitude 146.491594 latitude -37.565657
- generally north-easterly in a straight line from that point for approximately 1.1 kilometres to a point on the Jamieson-Licola Road at longitude 146.494775 latitude -37.556235

- generally north-westerly along that road to where it separates from the Australian Alps Walking Track at approximately longitude 146.406385 latitude -37.475751
- generally north-westerly and northerly along that walking track for about 3.3 kilometres until it meets the Jamieson-Licola Road again
- continuing northerly along that road (as part of the Australian Alps Walking Track) to its junction with Rumpff Saddle Road
- generally north-easterly following the Australian Alps Walking Track (initially following Rumpff Saddle Road) through the Alpine National Park and along Selwyn Track, the Great Dividing Range Track, Twins Jeep Track and Twins Road to its intersection with the Great Alpine Road about 700 metres north-east of the summit of Mt Saint Bernard
- generally north-easterly and then generally south-easterly along that road to a point at the eastern edge of the Mount Hotham Alpine Resort at longitude 147.197069 latitude -37.022329
- south south-easterly in a straight line from that point for about 10 kilometres to longitude 147.206583 latitude -37.111407
- east south-easterly in a straight line from that point for about 10.6 kilometres to a point on the Dinner Plain Track at longitude 147.325598 latitude -37.121957
- generally south-easterly along that track until it ends at Birregun Road
- generally south-easterly along that road for about 3 kilometres to its junction with Mt Phipps Track
- north-easterly along that track for about 1800 metres to a point at longitude 147.428207 latitude -37.207831
- north in a straight line from that point for about 260 metres to a point at the beginning of Spring Creek at longitude 147.428123. latitude -37.205554
- north downstream along that creek for about 2 kilometres to longitude 147.426368. latitude -37.187886
- east in a straight line from that point for about 3.1 kilometres to longitude 147.461638 latitude -37.187262
- north-easterly in a straight line from that point for about 600 metres to longitude 147.466652 latitude -37.183483
- north in a straight line from that point for about 4.5 kilometres to longitude 147.466286 latitude -37.143372
- north-easterly in a straight line from that point for about 1700 metres to a point on the Great Alpine Road at longitude 147.478572 latitude -37.132579

- easterly along that road to where it crosses Livingstone Creek about 2.5 kilometres southwest of Omeo
- southerly upstream along that creek to the point where it is entered by Three Mile Creek
- south-easterly upstream along that creek for about 2.5 kilometres to a point at longitude 147.600296 latitude -37.157862
- east south-easterly in a straight line from that point to a point on the Great Alpine Road at longitude 147.690387 latitude -37.170176
- north-westerly along that road for about 300 metres to its intersection with Tongio Gap Road
- north-westerly along that road to its intersection with Splitters Range Road
- generally easterly along that road to its junction with Old Splitters Track
- generally northerly along that track until it meets Splitters Range Road again
- continuing generally northerly along that road to its junction with McKenzies Road and Scrubby Creek Track
- generally south-easterly along Scrubby Creek Track to its junction with Bowen Bridge Track and Spring Hill Track
- generally southerly along Spring Hill Track to its junction with Mt Shaw Track
- generally south-easterly along that track for about 2.2 kilometres to its junction with the Bicentennial National Trail (not in the VicRoads Directory)
- southerly and then generally easterly along that trail to its junction with Scrubby Creek Track
- southerly along that track for about 160 metres across the Tambo River to its junction with the Bicentennial National Trail (not in the VicRoads Directory) and Bindi Road
- continuing generally north-easterly and northerly along the Bicentennial National Trail to its junction with Marble Gully Track
- generally north-easterly and then south-easterly along that track to its junction with Escarpment Track and Nunniong Plains Track
- generally south-easterly along Nunniong Plains Track to its intersection with Nunniong Road
- north-easterly along that road for about 2.5 kilometres to its junction with Wheatfields Road
- north-easterly along that road for about 420 metres to its junction with an unnamed track (not in the VicRoads Directory)

- south-easterly along that track to its junction with Timbarra Track
- generally easterly along that track for about 1600 metres to a point at longitude 147.997811 latitude -37.137953
- south in a straight line from this point for about 9.8 kilometres to longitude 148.001425 latitude -37.226454
- east in a straight line from that point for about 10.1 kilometres to longitude 148.115484 latitude -37.225458
- north north-easterly from that point for about 1600 metres to a point on the Buchan River at longitude 148.119115 latitude -37.211513
- northerly upstream along that river to the point where it is crossed by Green Gully Track
- generally north-westerly along that track to its intersection with Mundys Plain Track
- easterly and then generally south-easterly along that track until it becomes Bald Hills Road
- continuing generally easterly along that road to its junction with Midnight Track
- generally south-easterly along that track to its junction with Robinson Road
- continuing generally south-easterly along that road to its junction with Glenmore Road
- south-westerly along that road to the point where it crosses the Murrindal River
- southerly downstream along that river to a point about 400 metres downstream from its junction with Wagtail Creek at longitude 148.226200 latitude -37.302057
- west in a straight line from that point for about 1700 metres to a point at the junction of Razor Back Track and Wattle Ridge Track at longitude 148.207713 latitude -37.302484
- generally north-westerly along Wattle Ridge Track to its junction with Dawson Track
- generally south along that track for about 7.2 kilometres to longitude 148.192407 latitude -37.336219
- due east from that point in a straight line for about 30 metres to the head of an unnamed creek at longitude 148.192730 latitude -37.336219
- generally east south-easterly downstream along that creek to where it is crossed by Hodges Track

- easterly along that track for about 100 metres to where it crosses the Murrindal River
- northerly upstream along that river for about 30 metres to longitude 148.214490 latitude -37.338979
- easterly in a straight line from that point to a point on the Gelantipy Road at longitude 148.228832 latitude -37.339113
- north-easterly along that road for about 530 metres to longitude 148.231827 latitude -37.3351390
- east south-easterly in a straight line from that point for about 1 kilometre to longitude 148.242720 latitude -37.336708
- easterly in a straight line from that point for about 2.2 kilometres to longitude 148.267554 latitude -37.336915
- northerly in a straight line from that point for about 1.5 kilometres to longitude 148.26836 latitude -37.323832
- easterly in a straight line from that point for about 800 metres to a point on Butchers Creek at longitude 148.276949 latitude -37.323838
- southerly downstream along that creek for about 2.5 kilometres to longitude 148.269467 latitude -37.337387
- easterly in a straight line from that point for about 8.9 kilometres to a point on the Snowy River at longitude 148.369726 148.267554 latitude -37.337122
- southerly along that river downstream to its mouth at Bass Strait at longitude 148.548820 latitude -37.802040
- south from this point for 3 nautical miles into Bass Strait to a point at longitude 148.551420 latitude -37.852471
- continuing south-westerly along the coast at a distance of 3 nautical miles from the mean low water mark to a point south of Snake Island at longitude 146.594449 latitude -38.828750
- west north-westerly in a straight line for about 12 kilometres from this point to Entrance Point at the north-eastern extremity of Wilsons Promontory at longitude 146.468503 latitude -38.781639
- following the mean low water mark westerly for about 3 kilometres to a point at longitude 146.438016 latitude -38.778695
- north north-westerly in a straight line across the entrance to Corner Inlet for about 6.8 kilometres from this point to a point on the opposite coastline at longitude 146.408210 latitude -38.722274, about 2 kilometres east of Barry Point
- along the mean low water mark of Corner Inlet to the mouth of the Franklin River at Port Franklin township at longitude 146.282745 latitude -38.685551

- generally northerly upstream along that river to the point where it is entered by Deep Creek
- generally north-westerly along that creek to the point where it is crossed by the Boolarra-Foster Road
- generally northerly and north-easterly along that road until it joins Grand Ridge Road
- Continuing northerly along that road until it joins Boolarra Road at the intersection of Olsens Road
- continuing northerly along Boolarra Road to its junction with the Boolarra South-Mirboo North Road
- westerly along that road to its junction with Old Foster Road
- generally northerly along that road to its junction with the Boolarra-Mirboo North Road
- westerly along that road to its junction with the Strzelecki Highway in Mirboo North township
- northerly and north-easterly along the Strzelecki Highway for about 8 kilometres to its junction with the Mirboo North-Trafalgar Road
- northerly, then westerly and then northerly along that road to its junction with the Morwell-Thorpdale Road and the Childers – Thorpdale Road in Thorpdale township
- westerly along the Childers – Thorpdale Road to its junction with the Allambee – Childers Road
- north-westerly along that road to its junction with the Yarragon-Leongatha Road
- south-westerly along the Yarragon-Leongatha Road to its junction with McDonalds Track
- westerly along McDonalds Track to its junction with Grand Ridge Road
- south-westerly and then southerly along that road to a point at longitude 145.932721 latitude -38.280968
- west north-westerly in a straight line from that point for about 3.2 kilometres to a point on the Korumburra-Warragul Road at longitude 145.896439 latitude -38.277483
- northerly along the Korumburra-Warragul Road (as Howitt and Alfred Streets in Warragul) to its junction with Brandy Creek Road (as Victoria Street) and

the Drouin-Warragul Road (as Queen Street) in Warragul township where the boundary began.

##### **Reference Datum**

Geographical coordinates are referenced to the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 (GDA94), in decimal degrees.

##### **Reference Data and Source:**

- Roads & Rivers Centrelines are based on topographic vector data (1:25,000) sourced from the Land Information Group, Land Victoria, Department of Sustainability and Environment, (VicMap Data), VIC (April 2006).
- Road reserve boundaries are determined from property data sourced from the Land Information Group, Land Victoria, Department of Sustainability and Environment, (VicMap Data), VIC (April 2006).

##### **Interpretation**

- Where a boundary follows a linear feature such as a road or stream, the boundary is the centreline of that feature unless otherwise specified.
- Wherever possible, road names used in a boundary description are as shown in the VicRoads Country Street Directory of Victoria. Alternate road names or route numbers are included where necessary to improve the clarity of the description.
- Coordinates, expressed in degrees of latitude and longitude, are included for points where the location of a boundary might otherwise be uncertain (for

example, the point at which a road crosses a meandering stream). In some cases, a boundary may also be described as a series of straight lines joining coordinate points.
