


Approved Form under section 164 of the *Aboriginal Heritage Act 2006*

# Inspector's Identity Card for the purposes of the *Aboriginal Heritage Act 2006*

This form, approved by the Secretary, Department of Planning and Community Development, specifies the format in which an identity card must be presented by an inspector, appointed by the Minister under Section 160(1) of the *Aboriginal Heritage Act 2006*.
