TATI TATI ENCOURAGED TO RESUBMIT RAP APPLICATION

The Victorian Aboriginal Heritage Council has decided not to appoint Tati Tati Aboriginal Corporation as a registered Aboriginal party (RAP) at this time.

However, the Council considers Tati Tati may be a suitable candidate for future registration as a RAP and has encouraged Tati Tati to submit a new application which addresses a number of important issues raised by the Council.

The Council has also asked Tati Tati to discuss its application with its neighbours.

The Council is also mindful of unresolved native title issues in the area and wants to ensure, as best as possible, that complimentary outcomes are achieved.

To support this approach, Council is giving priority consideration to RAP applications made on behalf of Traditional Owner groups.
