AREA BOUNDARIES IN RELATION TO REGISTERED ABORIGINAL PARTIES

TAUNGURUNG CLANS ABORIGINAL CORPORATION

(Registered 16/07/2009. Modified 27/08/2009)

The boundary begins where the Bendigo – Murchison Road crosses the Campaspe River and continues progressively clockwise:

- south-easterly and then easterly along that road to where it crosses the Waranga Western Main Channel immediately after its junction with Guy Road
- north-easterly along that channel to the boundary of the Yorta Yorta native title application at longitude 145.016374 latitude -36.541471
- generally south-easterly along the boundary of the Yorta Yorta native title application to the point at longitude 145.431622 latitude -36.762269 where Geodetic Road crosses Creightons Creek near Longwood, passing through the following co-ordinate points—

- generally north-easterly along the boundary of the Yorta Yorta native title application to a point on Baddaginnie Creek at longitude 145.885691 latitude -36.639105, passing through the following co-ordinate points—

- southerly upstream along that creek for about 4.5 kilometres to where it is entered by an unnamed creek (not in the VicRoads Country Street Directory of Victoria, Edition 7) at longitude 145.882629 latitude -36.672284

- south-easterly upstream along that unnamed creek for about 2.8 kilometres to where it is entered by another, very minor, short unnamed stream (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 145.906309 latitude -36.683743
- continuing south-easterly upstream along this very minor stream for about 300 metres to the 240m contour (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 145.908575 latitude -36.685192
- starting northerly but winding generally easterly along the 240m contour for about 10.5 kilometres to longitude 145.960444 latitude -36.687889
- east in a straight line from that point for about 3 kilometres to a point on the Broken River at longitude 145.994552 latitude -36.687889
- southerly upstream along that river to the point where it is dammed to form Lake Nillahcootie
- southerly along the high water mark of the western side of that lake to where it is entered by the Broken River
- continuing southerly and then generally east south-easterly upstream along that river to where it is entered by an unnamed stream at longitude 146.345908 latitude -37.03063
- continuing south-easterly upstream along that unnamed stream for about 300 metres to its source about 150 metres north-west of the summit of Bald Hill at longitude 146.349408 latitude -37.03143
- generally easterly and north-easterly for about 300 metres across the northern ridge of Bald Hill and Cambatong Road to the source of an unnamed stream (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 146.352231 latitude -37.030401
- north-easterly downstream along that stream for about 2.6 kilometres to where it enters Evans Creek at longitude 146.377182 latitude -37.020288
- southerly upstream along that creek for about 270 metres to where it is entered by another unnamed stream (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 146.377535 latitude -37.022777
- south-easterly upstream along that stream for about 4.5 kilometres to the point where it is crossed by the Buckland Spur Track at longitude 146.411885 latitude -37.039757
- north north-easterly in a straight line from that point for about 230 metres to the source of Tomahawk Creek at longitude 146.412268 latitude -37.037777
- north-easterly downstream along the length of that creek to where it enters the King River
- generally south-easterly upstream along that river to where it splits into the King River North Branch and the King River South Branch

- southerly and the south-easterly upstream along the King River South Branch to its source at longitude 146.646279 latitude -37.162618
- east in a straight line from that point for about 100 metres to a point on the Australian Alps Walking Track at longitude 146.646973 latitude -37.161814
- beginning south-easterly, but then generally south-westerly along that walking track (finally following Rumpff Saddle Road) to the point where it crosses the 1520 metre contour at longitude 146.394786 latitude -37.435404
- north-westerly along that contour for about 340 metres to where it is crossed by the Jamieson – Licola Road at longitude 146.392565 latitude -37.433156
- north-westerly along that road for about 260 metres to where it re-crosses the 1520 metre contour at longitude 146.391170 latitude -37.4312390
- generally north-westerly and northerly along that contour looping south-westerly, southerly and then south-easterly around the summit of Mount Skene to where it is crossed by an unnamed track at longitude 146.380986 latitude -37.422686
- southerly along that track to its junction with the Jamieson – Licola Road at longitude 146.381019 latitude -37.425404
- south-easterly in a straight line from that point for about 75 metres to the 1520 metre contour at longitude 146.381544 latitude -37.425907
- south-easterly along that contour for about 660 metres to longitude 146.387198 latitude -37.429020
- southerly downhill from that point for about 230 metres to the 1440 metre contour at longitude 146.387177 latitude -37.430985
- south-easterly along that contour to where it is crossed by the Jamieson – Licola Road at longitude 146.392628 latitude -37.444263
- generally southerly along that road (as part of the Australian Alps Walking Track) for about 1 kilometre to where it separates from the Australian Alps Walking Track at longitude 146.390413 latitude -37.453517
- generally southerly and south-easterly along that walking track for about 3.3 kilometres until it meets the Jamieson – Licola Road again at longitude 146.406385 latitude -37.475751
- generally south-easterly along that road (as part of the Australian Alps Walking Track) to the point where it again separates from the Australian Alps Walking Track at longitude 146.417019 latitude -37.495356
- generally southerly along that walking track for about 12 kilometres to longitude 146.398071 latitude -37.580638
- generally south-westerly in a straight line from that point for approximately 1.4 kilometres to longitude 146.394876 latitude -37.592926

- generally south easterly uphill along a spur from that point for about 500 metres to the 1220 metre contour at longitude 146.395619 latitude -37.597394
- generally westerly along that contour looping around the summit of Mount Stander and continuing generally south-easterly to where it is crossed by an unnamed track at longitude 146.385303 latitude -37.599486
- easterly and south-easterly in an arc from this point to Mt Selma Road at longitude 146.390859 latitude -37.602903
- generally southerly and south-westerly along that road from that point for about 1.5 kilometres to longitude 146.383369 latitude -37.610338
- westerly in a straight line from that point for about 2.5 kilometres to longitude 146.355460 latitude -37.610602
- northerly in a straight line from that point for about 1 kilometre to longitude 146.355108 latitude -37.601446
- westerly in a straight line from that point for about 1500 metres to longitude 146.337765 latitude -37.601710
- southerly in a straight line from that point for about 1500 metres to Walhalla Road at longitude 146.338029 latitude -37.615444
- north-westerly and then south-westerly along that road to its junction with the Warburton – Woods Point Road
- generally westerly and north-westerly and south-westerly along that road, forming the northern boundary of the Yarra Ranges National Park, to its junction with the Marysville – Woods Point Road
- westerly along that road for about 1800 metres to its intersection with Cambarville Road
- north-easterly along that road to its junction with Snowy Hill Road (not in the VicRoads Directory)
- generally northerly along that road to its end at longitude 145.880496 latitude -37.522742
- west in a straight line for about 550 metres to a point on the Lake Mountain Road longitude 145.874537 latitude -37.522742
- south-westerly and then northerly along that road for about 1200 metres to longitude 145.867726 latitude -37.527606
- southerly along the ridge line for about 2.7 kilometres to join the end of an unnamed track (not in the VicRoads Directory) and continuing along that track for a further 800 metres to its junction with the Marysville – Woods Point Road at longitude 145.857146 latitude -37.552902
- north-westerly along that road to its junction with Tommys Bend Road

- generally south-westerly along the northern boundary of the Yarra Ranges National Park to the junction of the MMBW Boundary Road (not named in the VicRoads Directory) and the Strickland Spur Track and Road 8 (the boundary is defined by a number of tracks along the ridge of the Great Dividing Range including: Tommys Bend Road; several unnamed tracks; Paradise Plains Road; and the MMBW Boundary Road)
- continuing southerly along Road 8, following the ridge of the Great Dividing Range and forming the boundary of the Yarra Ranges National Park, to its junction with an unnamed track (not in the VicRoads Directory) at 145.747122 longitude -37.670334 latitude
- south-easterly along the length of this track for about 1200 metres until it joins Road 10
- southerly along Road 10 to its junction with Road 14 (not in the VicRoads Directory)
- north-westerly along that road to its intersection with Acheron Way (Donna Buang Road) and Road 7
- generally north-westerly along Road 7 to its junction with an unnamed track (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 145.768972 latitude -37.684536
- north-westerly along that track, following the ridge of the Great Dividing Range, to its junction with Road 27
- northerly along that road following the ridge of the Great Dividing Range for about 600 metres to its junction with Mt Vinegar Road and Road 8
- north-westerly along Road 8 for about 8 kilometres generally following the Park boundary to its junction with an unnamed (not in the VicRoads Directory) track at longitude 145.658791 latitude -37.614534
- northerly along that track for about 1 kilometre, following the Park boundary, until it rejoins Road 8 at longitude 145.655002 latitude -37.60724
- continuing north-westerly along Road 8 for about 2.3 kilometres following the Park boundary along the Great Dividing Range to its junction with the Maroondah Highway and Monda Road
- following Monda Road along the top of the Great Dividing Range and largely forming the northern boundary of the Yarra Ranges National Park to longitude 145.523554 latitude -37.561548
- following the top of the ridge line north-westerly for about 1300 metres from that point to the junction of Sylvia Creek Road and an unnamed track (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 145.513084 latitude -37.554991
- westerly along Sylvia Creek Road for about 900 metres to its junction with Myers Creek Road
- north-westerly along that road to its junction with the Healesville – Kinglake Road

- generally westerly along that road to its junction with Glenwood Drive
- south-westerly, north-westerly, and then northerly along Glenwood Drive to where it rejoins the Healesville – Kinglake Road
- westerly along that road for about 60 metres to its junction with the Melba Highway
- continuing westerly along the Healesville – Kinglake Road to its intersection with the Heidelberg – Kinglake Road and the Whittlesea – Kinglake Road at Kinglake township
- north-westerly and then generally westerly along the Whittlesea – Kinglake Road to its junction with the Whittlesea – Yea Road and Road 16 at Kinglake West
- north-westerly along Road 16 to its junction with Road 3 (not in the VicRoads Directory) at the eastern edge of the north-western component of Kinglake National Park
- generally north-westerly through the National Park along Road 3 to its junction with Board Road
- generally westerly and southerly and then north-westerly, following the western edge of the National Park, along Board Road to its intersection with Disappointment Road and Harpers Creek Road at the western edge of the north-western component of the Park
- north-westerly along Disappointment Road to its intersection with Escreets Road and Main Mountain Road
- continuing generally north-westerly along Main Mountain Road to its intersection with Drag Hill Road and South Mountain Road
- south-westerly and then north westerly along South Mountain Road to its junction with North Mountain Road
- north-westerly and then westerly along that road to its junction with Rail Street in Heathcote Junction township
- south-westerly in a straight line from that junction for about 40 metres to a point on the North Eastern Railway at longitude 145.028375 latitude - 37.372232
- north-westerly along that railway line for about 100 metres to its connection to a dismantled railway line (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 145.027836 latitude -37.371297
- generally westerly, then southerly and then north-westerly along that dismantled railway line to where it is crossed by Arkells Lane at longitude 144.990815 latitude -37.371864

- westerly along that road for about 1 kilometre to longitude 144.979458 latitude -37.370238
- south-westerly and then north-westerly from that junction along the ridge of the Great Dividing Range for about 2 kilometres, through longitude 144.970239 latitude -37.375472 on the Northern Highway, to the junction of an unnamed track (not in the VicRoads Directory), Old Sydney Road and Beauview Drive
- northerly along the unnamed track to its end at the Northern Highway
- north-westerly along that Highway for about 1500 metres to its intersection with Union Lane
- westerly along Union Lane for about 200 metres to longitude 144.959391 latitude -37.353333
- generally north-westerly and then south-westerly from that point along the ridge of the Great Dividing Range for about 15 kilometres through the following points: longitude 144.959391 latitude -37.343025 on Mill Road; longitude 144.936355 latitude -37.322544 on Gehreys Lane; longitude 144.924647 latitude -37.315504 on Paynes Road; and longitude 144.895033 latitude -37.300332 on High Park Road, to a point on the Kilmore – Lancefield Road at longitude 144.851277 latitude -37.310890
- north-westerly along that road for about 2.4 kilometres to its junction with an unnamed track (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 144.82825 latitude -37.301141
- northerly along that track for about 350 metres to its junction with the Old Kilmore - Lancefield Road
- northerly from that junction following the ridge of the Great Dividing Range for about 1400 metres to the junction of Goldie Mine Road and an unnamed track (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 144.831468 latitude -37.286533
- northerly along that track following the ridge of the Great Dividing Range for about 6 kilometres to its junction with the Willowmavin – Tantaraboo Road
- north-westerly along that road for about 250 metres to longitude 144.827667 latitude -37.23388
- north-westerly and then westerly following the ridge of the Great Dividing Range from that point for approximately 1.6 kilometres to a point on Mt William Road at longitude 144.818373 latitude -37.225435
- northerly along that road for about 1.8 kilometres before turning west for a further 100 metres along that road to where it becomes Boland Road
- northerly along that road for about 2.3 kilometres to its junction with the Pyalong – Lancefield Road
- south-westerly along that road to its junction with Allisons Road

- generally westerly along that road to where it crosses an unnamed stream (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 144.755285 latitude -37.205947
- north-westerly downstream from that point along that watercourse for about 350 metres to the point where it enters another unnamed stream (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 144.752528 latitude -37.204409
- south-westerly and westerly upstream along that watercourse for about 1.2 kilometres to where it is crossed by the Lancefield – Tooborac Road at longitude 144.741957 latitude -37.209589
- north along that road for about 270 metres to its junction with Mitchells Road (not in the VicRoads Directory)
- westerly along the length of that road for about 1 kilometre to longitude 144.730062 latitude -37.207109
- following the ridge of the Great Dividing Range from that point for approximately 7.2 kilometres beginning south-westerly, then generally westerly and then generally north-westerly to the junction of Burke and Wills Track and Long Ryans Road (not named in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 144.675082 latitude -37.208051
- north-westerly along the Burke and Wills Track for about 860 metres to longitude 144.665764 latitude -37.205964
- following the ridge of the Great Dividing from that point for approximately 19 kilometres in a broad arc beginning south-westerly and then generally southerly, passing through the following points: longitude 144.657631 latitude -37.214696 on Reillys Road; longitude 144.624075 latitude -37.232045 on Ridge Road; longitude 144.580711 latitude -37.259574 on Dohertys Road; longitude 144.574223 latitude -37.28144 on Three Chain Road; and longitude 144.586983 latitude -37.309182 on Jim Road, to a point on Coach Road at longitude 144.591492 latitude -37.317968
- southerly along that road to its junction with Lancefield Road
- south-westerly and then westerly along that road to longitude 144.553877 latitude -37.350521
- north north-westerly in a straight line for about 28.5 kilometres from that point to a point on the Campaspe River at longitude 144.507226 latitude -37.095311
- north-easterly and then generally northerly downstream along that river to where it is crossed by the Heathcote – Kyneton Road at Redesdale township
- generally south-westerly along that road for about 1 kilometre to its junction with School Road (not named in the VicRoads Country Street Directory of Victoria, Edition 7)
- south-westerly along the length of that road to its junction with the Bendigo – Redesdale Road (Lyell Road)

- westerly and then northerly along that road to its junction with Redesdale Road North
- north north-easterly along that road to its end at the junction of some unnamed tracks (not in the VicRoads Directory) at longitude 144.542365 latitude -36.935163
- easterly along the track heading east to its end by the high water mark of Lake Eppalock at longitude 144.548809 latitude -36.936377
- east in a straight line from that point to a point in Lake Eppalock to the former course of the Campaspe River at longitude 144.552265 latitude -36.936377
- generally northerly through Lake Eppalock along that former river course to the dam at the Knowsley - Eppalock Road
- continuing northerly downstream along the Campaspe River to where it is crossed by the Bendigo – Murchison Road, where the boundary began.

Reference Datum

Geographical coordinates are referenced to the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 (GDA94), in decimal degrees.

Reference Data and Source:

- Roads & Rivers Centrelines are based on topographic vector data (1:25,000) sourced from the Land Information Group, Land Victoria, Department of Sustainability and Environment, (VicMap Data), VIC (April 2006).
- Road reserve boundaries are determined from property data sourced from the Land Information Group, Land Victoria, Department of Sustainability and Environment, (VicMap Data), VIC (April 2006).

- Mean Low Water Mark is based on coastline data sourced from Geoscience Australia (1998).

Interpretation

- Where a boundary follows a linear feature such as a road or stream, the boundary is the centreline of that feature unless otherwise specified.
- Wherever possible, road names used in a boundary description are as shown in the VicRoads Country Street Directory of Victoria. Alternate road names or route numbers are included where necessary to improve the clarity of the description.
- Coordinates, expressed in degrees of latitude and longitude, are included for points where the location of a boundary might otherwise be uncertain (for example, the point at which a road crosses a meandering stream). In some cases, a boundary may also be described as a series of straight lines joining coordinate points.
