

Main Menu

The main menu (pictured below) allows the user to search for projects, build maps and reports, and display a legend identifying each UDP land supply theme.

Search

The search tool allows the user to find their area of interest. You can search by any of the following:

- estate
- government area
- address
- lot on plan number
- Melway map reference.

Build Map

- Turn themes or layers on and off, such as broadhectare residential, planning zones and overlays, roads and municipal boundaries
- Turn sub-layers on and off, such as specific land supply categories, residential broadhectare take-up of one to two years, or industrial vacant land zoned Business 3.

Get Report

- Generate statistical/mapping reports for any location or UDP theme within metropolitan Melbourne and the Geelong Region. For example, you can create a report of recent residential redevelopment activity by individual project or a combination of projects
- All reports contain tabular and map information
- All reports are printable and have copy/paste functions suitable for Microsoft Excel or Word.

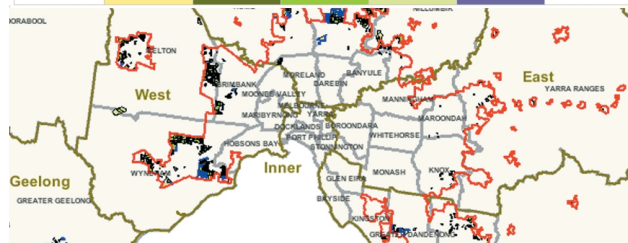

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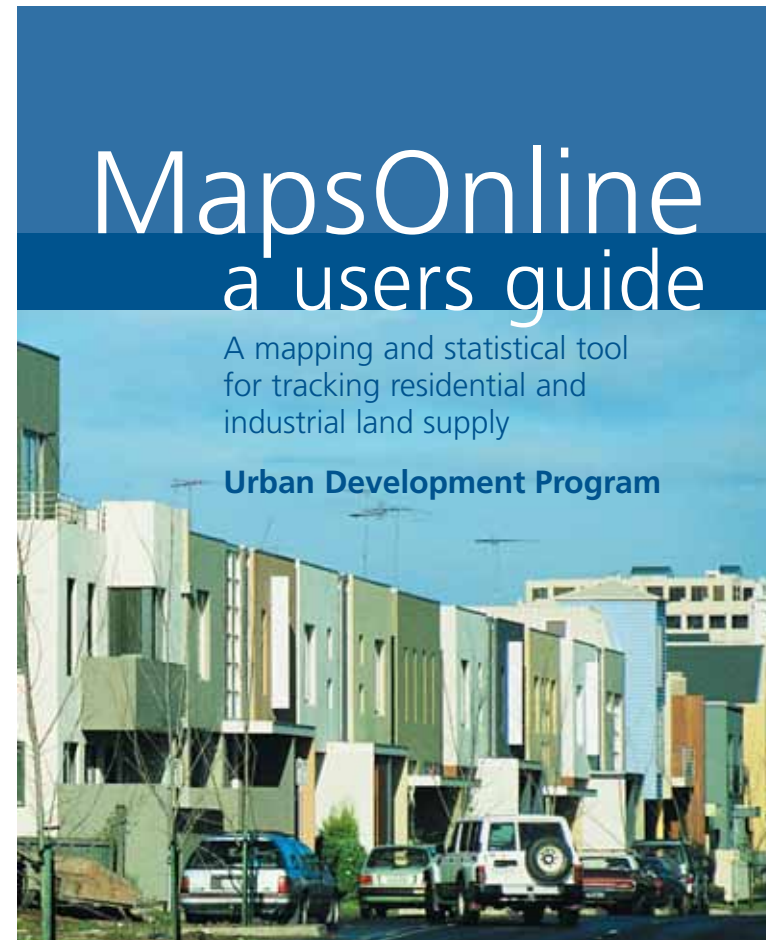

What is MapsOnline?

MapsOnline is a valuable mapping and statistical tool for tracking residential and industrial land supply across metropolitan Melbourne and the Geelong Region.

Developed as part of the Urban Development Program (UDP), MapsOnline can search for specific projects, generate reports and allows users to print or download maps and statistical reports.

The UDP is a major Victorian Government initiative to support the implementation of the 30-year metropolitan strategy, *Melbourne 2030*.

The purpose of the UDP is to ensure adequate residential and industrial land is available to meet future needs.

Users of MapsOnline can access specific land supply data by region, local government area, estate name, Melway reference, street address, lot number or a user defined catchment.

They can also extract detailed information on specific project areas with a click of a button, including details of the projected development timing, anticipated dwelling or lot yield, zoning and project area.

Getting Started

To start, go to www.land.vic.gov.au/udp

From here you can launch MapsOnline by choosing one of three UDP themes:

1. Broadhectare Residential
2. Established Residential
3. Industrial

Map Buttons

Above the map window, there are a number of buttons to drive the map window.



Viewing tools	use to zoom-in/out and pan.
Information tool	use to interrogate database behind each UDP land parcel.
Selection tool	use to select areas and generate a report.
Measure tool	use to measure distances on the map.
Print tool	use to produce a PDF map.
Map tool help	used to explain the map tool functions.
Metro map	use to reset the initial map view on start-up.
Change theme menu	use to change to any UDP theme at any time.
