

**Approved Form under schedule 2, c 7.1 of the Aboriginal Heritage Regulations 2007**

# Map of the Activity Area of a Cultural Heritage Management Plan for the purposes of the *Aboriginal Heritage Act 2006*

This form, approved by the Secretary, Department of Planning and Community Development specifies the format in which a map describing the activity area of a Cultural Heritage Management Plan ("Management Plan") must be prepared.

1. The map must include the following:
  - a) a description of what the map represents;
  - b) details of the location of the boundaries of the activity area;
  - c) the municipal district (if any) in which the area is located;
  - d) the salient prominent structures and works in, and natural features of, the activity area;
  - e) a legend explaining the symbols used to represent features on the map;
  - f) a scale shown as either a unit measure (such as 1:50 000) or by a graphic bar;
  - g) an arrow indicating which direction is north; and
  - h) a small diagram showing the location of the area depicted on the map in relation to the nearest major town.
2. The map must show any registration on the Victorian Aboriginal Heritage Register within the activity area and within 200 metres of the boundary of the activity area, at the time the desktop assessment for the Management Plan was undertaken.
